

Melanie Dobson Confronts Adoption Fears during National Adoption Month

- WHAT?** While so many women dream of becoming a mom, more than 6.1 women in the U.S. have had trouble getting pregnant. Melanie Dobson is available in November to discuss her emotional journey with infertility as well as the struggles and joys of adoption.
- WHO?** Melanie wrote the inspirational novel *Together for Good* (Kregel, 2006) to confront the fear of failed adoption. She is the former corporate publicity manager at Focus on the Family and the mother of two adopted girls.
- WHY?** As 2.1 million married couples battle infertility, an increasing number of Christian couples are considering adoption. But in spite of the success stories, the fear persists that once a child is placed in their home and the loving bond sealed, the birthmother will change her mind. Melanie confronts this fear of failed adoption through a powerful story that demonstrates the strength of both birth and adoptive families as well as the healing power of God.
